

Faith Harvest Helpers

Faith Harvest Helpers has been active in a food ministry the past five years. The headquarters are located in Tumwater, with a distribution center in Yelm and food banks in Yelm, Lacey and Redmond, Oregon. The outreach portion of FHH has existed for over 20 years. They supply food to 26 foodbanks and 5 feeding programs. In addition, containers of non-perishable foods, Christian literature and medical supplies are shipped. Their vision is to share GOD's love and care within the local community and then the world. FHH acts as a supporting and partnering ministry to several Youth With A Mission ministries, including Gleanings For The Hungry.

Ministries leaders, Paul and Rose Shorb, are currently completing their Discipleship Training School and are in the process of submitting application to the Northwest Director of *YWAM* to establish a *YWAM* ministry center. *FHH* has partenered with *Gleanings* for the past 5 years through the distribution of canned salmon. The vision of *Faith Harvest Helpers* includes a Discipleship Training School, commercial cannery, fish processing facility and a gleaning and distribution center. Below is a picture of the new 44.5 acre property *FFH* is in the process of acquiring in Yelm, Washington to house this growing ministry. The utilities (power and water) included are more than adequate and the land will provide space for today, as well as enhancements for future vision. Your prayers and support are appreciated, as finances are still needed to complete the purchase.



There are currently over 400 volunteers serving at *FHH*. Many volunteers work to sort and package the fresh fruits and vegetables that arrive at the Yelm Distribution Center. "We are feeding 2,500 people a week through over 70 feeding programs, for a total of 1,298,675 lbs of food per year to date. If you would like to help us, come, we have a place for you!"
