When her parents return they give thanks to God for the day's provision and ask that He help them every day. Today Sofia and her family are thankful for the gift of soup that they have received and her parents tell us that there are many days they go home with their hands empty, but today is different. They have hope that there will be better days for their family.

Marta is a single mom who struggles to support her four children. Today she left home very early in order to find food for them; she is scared and broken-hearted because she has to leave them alone, otherwise there would be no food on the table. She is surprised and happy to find *Hope of Life* sharing the blessing of soup mix with all the families of her village. Marta sends her blessings to everyone at *Gleanings* for their gift. These are the words expressed by a single mom with much gratitude in her heart.

At 7 years old Carla Julissa has seen how her family suffers from the poverty she was born into. She has four younger brothers that she cares for after school, so that her mother can find work in the afternoon to support the family. There are many days when she doesn't find work after going door to door and Carla's father comes home from the fields with near to nothing to buy beans and tortillas for the family. Today they are blessed with a gift of soup full of much needed nutrients. They ask us to thank *Gleanings* for this blessing and know the value of the sup-

port. We thank God for all the people that are involved in making this gift a reality. Without *Gleanings*' support we could not reach them.
