As of this past semester, I have been attending Vanguard University of Southern California where I am majoring in sociology. More importantly, I am minoring in women's studies where we look at the theoretical and practical overview of the study of women and women's issues in society, and will include course work in the social sciences, religion, literature, history, and communications. I have been accepted to participate in the Global Center for Women and Justice's study abroad intensive to Greece from June 17th-27th.
