F rom June to August 2023, **Gleanings** processed over five million pounds of peaches and nectarines, producing over 197,000 pounds of nutritious food for hungry people around the world. This translates to about 792,000 servings of dried fruit given in Jesus' name. In addition, a small team of volunteers produced over 1,784,450 servings of soup mix in less than three months.

Wow! A big thank you goes out to the generous farmers and packing houses who donated peaches and nectarines this summer! Thank you to the faithful youth groups, churches, supporters, donors, and truck drivers. Thank you to our Summer Staff, full-time staff, Mission Builders, backpackers, and local volunteers. Thank you to our ministry partners, cooks, missionaries, teachers, guest speakers, church leaders. Thank you YWAM family. It's a joy to serve God together. Most of our dried peaches will go to Nicaragua, Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Philippines, Cuba, Ukraine, and Mexico. And for the first time, these peaches will go to eSwatini. We trust that this food will bring glory to the name of Jesus.

NEW WAREHOUSE At gleanings

We've officially broken ground on our second Gleanings warehouse, and it couldn't come at a better time! As the Lord continues to bless Gleanings with ingredients and truckloads of food, the incoming and outgoing product is becoming too much to store. The new warehouse will double the size of the current space, extending it onto the end of the existing warehouse. Its size will enable Gleanings to have an increased flexibility for product movement, allow for more time to store loads with detailed shipping requirements, and expand our ministry opportunities both locally and internationally. "We want to be good stewards of what we've been given," said Director, Fritz Meier.

While we await building permits, excavators were able to dig a hole this August for the concrete footings of the warehouse floor. Staff member, Al Gove, is leading the project through coordination with local companies. *Gleanings* will be purchasing steel members through *Borga Steel* in Selma to construct the 100x120-foot frame. In faith, we are seeking the Lord to provide the funding for the rest of this project.

We joyfully invite you to participate in building a second warehouse, as we praise God for the abundance of food product He has sent to *Gleanings*. We trust Him to see it through. Colombia Movements of Grace

"We have a dream to make our own soup mix right here in Colombia!" It was October 2019 in a small upstairs office in Bogota, Colombia. Fritz Meier and Andy Rotunno sat listening to *Julian Camargo* share a vision for the future. "Yes, we want to import containers of *Gleanings* soup mix to minister to Venezuelan migrant families, as well as the needy people of Colombia," Julian continued. "We also believe that we, the Colombian church, can work together to rescue wasted food in Colombia and make a healthy soup mix here, to help us share the love of Christ."



The small team traveled around the country meeting dedicated missionaries and suffering migrant families. At the time, in the wake of so much need and so many challenges, the dream of a Colombian soup mix seemed impossible. Two years later, in fall 2021, Julian and his wife Doris came to *Gleanings* for two months to see how everything worked. A very resourceful, highachieving couple with many gifts and talents, they took what they learned here, went back to their home country, and got to work, networking and establishing their own product, which they called *Mezcla de Sopa*.


"I met on video calls with the team from Colombia, Movements Of Grace," Andy said. "They were serious about the project and wanted to know the call, project leader Iuliana Castillo asked many questions. How does *Gleanings* do it? What's your recipe? Where do you get the ingredients? How do you package the soup? Would Gleanings allow us to use this knowledge to create our own product? Yes, of course, we bless you. The soup mix is God's idea, not ours," Andy said.
